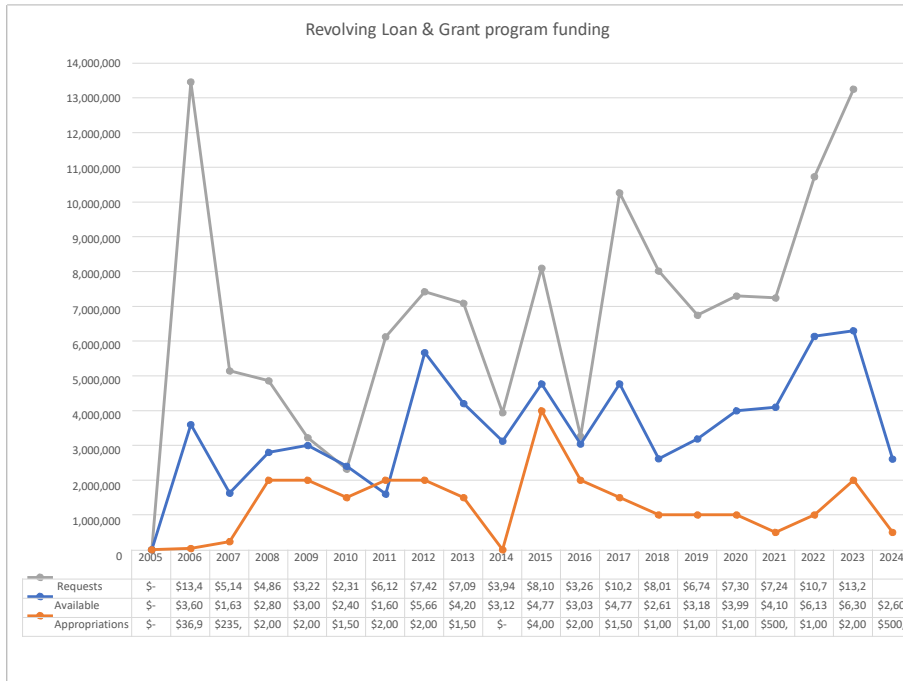
All agreement must be signed by the recipient within 180 days of award.
