All entries must be submitted by Oct. 7, 2022. Each participant may submit a maximum of 20 pictures for the contest. All photos must have an lowa connection and may include photos taken on travels away from lowa. Only digital entries will be accepted. Digital photos should be taken at the highest resolution possible.

#### **Awards**

Winners will receive certificates of recognition, and be recognized through statewide announcements and on the Office of Aviation's website.

Entries may be used to promote aviation in Iowa. All entries are subject to unlimited use by the Office of Aviation, and may be used without permission or credit. CDs will not be returned.
