**Monday, March 23, 2015, between 3:30 and 5:30 p.m.**

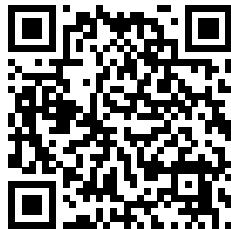
