

## PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

To discuss proposed  
improvements on  
U.S. 65 at Story  
County Road E-41  
(Lincoln Highway)  
in Story County

Thursday, June 23, 2016, 5 to 6:30 p.m.

The Iowa Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting to discuss the proposed project to either remove the existing bridge and raise the profile of U.S. 65 to meet the profile of Story County Road E-41 or repair the bridge over U.S. 65. If an at-grade intersection is constructed, stop signs will be placed on Story County Road E-41. The profile grade raise of U.S. 65 will require approximately 2,500 ft. of reconstruction.

To accommodate construction, U.S. 65 will be closed and an offsite detour will be utilized. It is anticipated that the detour will be in place for approximately 120 days. The detour would follow U.S. 30 west from the junction of U.S. 65 and U.S. 30 to Story County Road S-27 for 5 miles. The detour would continue turning north on Story County Road S-27 to Story County Road E-29 for 5 miles then east to the junction of U.S. 65.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting anytime between 5 and 6:30 p.m. at the Colo-Nesco Middle School, 919 West Street in Colo. The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.

The meeting space is accessible for persons with disabilities. However, if you require special accommodations at the meeting, please notify the Iowa DOT contact listed to the left by June 20.
