

## **Public Information Meeting**

to discuss proposed replacement of the bridges on Interstate 35 over the Skunk River, 2.6 miles south of U.S. 30, in Story County

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting anytime between 5 and 6:30 p.m. to discuss the proposed replacement of the bridges on I-35 over the Skunk River, 2.6 miles south of U.S. 30, in Story County. The proposed project would include widening approximately 1.5 miles of I-35 to six lanes and replacing the bridge over I-35 at Story County Road E-57.

Story County Road E-57 would be closed to through traffic during construction. A detour route will be established by the county closer to the time of construction.

The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.
