

Public Input Requested for proposed bridge replacement on lowa 12 in Plymouth County

The lowa Department of Transportation is requesting public input for a proposed bridge replacement on Iowa 12 over Indian Creek, 4 miles north of Plymouth County Road C-16. The project includes replacing the existing bridge with a 213-foot 10-inch x 40-inch three span pretensioned prestressed concrete beam bridge. The existing grade will be raised one foot and bridge approaches and guardrails will be replaced.

Through traffic on Iowa 12 would be detoured during construction using Plymouth County Roads C-12, K-18, and C-16. For more information, see the website below.

The project is scheduled to take place during 2021.
