WHEREAS, general aviation and airports play critical roles in the lives of Iowans, as well as the operation of businesses, industry, farms and recreation; and

WHEREAS, Iowa has a significant interest in the continued vitality of aviation, aircraft component manufacturing, aircraft maintenance and repair facilities, institutions providing aviation education, agricultural aviation, aviation organizations and airport operators; and

WHEREAS, Iowa is home to 114 airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Iowa's economy, it improves the overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, Iowa's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and direct investment in this critical infrastructure ensures future economic growth and the preparation of our next generation of aviation professionals, pilots, mechanics, and air travelers:
