Here's what we know

- Since our last update on Friday there have been an additional 246 positive cases reported for a total of 946 positive cases confirmed in Iowa. To get the latest stats and a map of counties with positive cases check the state's [COVID-19 website](#).

- Our employees are essential to keeping people, goods, and services that are necessary in the fight against COVID-19 moving.
