Here's what we know

- Since our last update on Monday there have been an additional 659 positive cases for a total of 15,614 positive cases confirmed. Iowa has had 33 additional deaths for a total of 388 in the state due to COVID-19. To date, 8,362 people who have tested positive have recovered. These numbers are as of 4:30 p.m. today.

Here's what we are doing externally

- Driver & Identification Services have increased the number of appointments they can offer in our service centers, while continuing to maintain proper social distancing. This should help with a backlog of customers who were unable to receive services previously. In addition, they are seeing an uptick of customers renewing online or taking advantage of the six month extension of their driving privileges which helps reduce the number of people who need to come into our facilities for service.
- Our MVE officers continue to work to help set up and move TestIowa sites as necessary. Two sites will be wrapping up this week with two sites being planned in new locations next week.
- MVE officers have also been assisting in the transport of test samples from several TestIowa sites and the State of Iowa Hygienic Lab.

We will continue to keep you informed on what the Iowa DOT is doing to respond. Please stay safe, stay home when possible, and remember to practice good hygiene and social distancing!
