THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION will hold
an Open Forum Design Public Hearing
on June 28, 2007, from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the
Sioux City Convention Center, 801 4th Street, Sioux City, IA,

to discuss the proposed reconstruction
of I-29, in Sioux City, from 1.5 miles
south of the IA 12/Riverside Boulevard
interchange north to the Big Sioux River

and

to provide an opportunity to review and comment on the
proposed *de minimis* effect of the I-29 segment 1 project
(south of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad) on
Chatauqua Park (a Section 4(f) Resource). *De minimis*
impacts on publicly owned parks, recreation areas, and
wildlife and waterfowl refuges are defined as those that
do not “adversely affect the activities, features and
attributes” of the Section 4(f) Resource.

Personnel will be available anytime between 5 and 7 p.m. to
individually discuss the proposed improvement.
