Do you like railroads, do you find them interesting and would like to work on rail related data efforts? If so, the Iowa Department of Transportation (Iowa DOT) is accepting applications for summer jobs as a rail crossing inventory data collector, with the department's Systems Planning Bureau. Applicants must be available from May 20, 2024, until mid-August 2024. The rail crossing inventory data collector position requires a valid driver's license as they will travel statewide and stay overnight from Sunday afternoons through Friday mornings.

Through this position, selected job candidates will travel to defined railroad crossings to take measurements and photos as well as collect data concerning railroad crossing attributes; and enter the information through software on an iPad. This requires working in all areas within the road right-of-way, near railroads and traffic, and in all weather conditions. A significant portion of the work will be in the southwestern quadrant of Iowa.

These positions all pay \$16.75 per hour with eligible incurred expenses for lodging and food reimbursement, and vehicles being supplied by the Iowa DOT.

Minimum Qualifications:

Most applicants must be at least 18 years old at the time of employment with possibly a few workers being 16-17 years old. Applicants must possess a valid U.S. driver's license.
