



Railroad Revolving Loan and Grant Program

- Created by legislation in 2005
- Purpose: To provide loans and grants for railroad related improvement projects to benefit lowa.
- Funded by loan repayments and appropriations by the lowa Legislature. Funding is available to cities, counties, economic development organizations and other non-profit organizations through an application program.



Available Funding and Application Summary

- FY 2022 Legislative appropriation (RIIF): \$1,000,000
- Loan repayment: \$1,423,746.14
- Rescinded funds \$3,715,000
- Total: \$6.1 million

Project Evaluation Criteria

Targeted Job Creation Projects:

Hourly wage rates must meet 100% of the average county wage criteria:



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Project MG -- Clinton

Company is building a plant to convert locally produced agricultural feedstock into renewable fuels. The rail facilities improvement will connect the plant to UP railroad. Project is expected to create 50 new jobs.

Total Cost: \$13,719,632

Requested: \$600,000 (4.4%) Recommended: \$550,000 (4%)




Charles City Terminal

The proposed project will re-purpose the former Oliver/White Tractor Manufacturing plant site as a railcar-truck transload center for transshipment of propane, bio-renewables, and specialized fuels through connections with both CP and CN railroads. Project is expected to create 20-25 new jobs.

Total Cost: \$5,276,000

Requested: \$1,340,000 (25%) Recommended: \$1,140,000 (21.6%)



Project Peony

Project is adding a switch and 15,750-foot rail spur to the planned industrial facility connecting it to the railroad network. Project is expected to create 180 new jobs.

Total Cost: \$5,197,674

Requested: \$2,160,000 (41.6%) Recommended: \$2,000,000 (38.5%)






CP Unit Train Expansion (Pattison Sand IV)The project will construct rail to add an additional 30 railcar spots in their yard as part of their long-term expansion plans. 15 jobs will be retained and 35 jobs will be created.

Total Cost: \$3,140,000

Requested: \$2,404,000 (76.6%) - Recommended: \$180,000 (0.6%)




Return to Recommendation Summary

Ten D/Merchants Railport Expansion and Upgrades

Project will add 1 mile+ new rail and replace/upgrade/make accessible 1.5 mile+ of existing rail. Also will add additional transloading service capacities and capabilities.

Total Cost: \$6,915,822

Requested: \$3,500,000 (50.6%) Recommended: \$1,500,000 (21.7%)




Boone and Scenic Valley Railroad Expansion and Upgrade

Project is replacing old, failing ties and constructing a new siding for additional storage and switching capabilities.

Total Cost: \$734,816

Requested: \$551,112 (75%) Recommended: \$551,112 (75%)




Oskaloosa Industrial Park Transload Facility

This planning study is looking at developing 29 acres of land near Oskaloosa into a railport/transload facility. The concept includes almost three miles of track and the potential of a diverse array of storage and transloading capabilities.

Total Cost: \$94,500

Requested: \$75,600 (80%) Recommended: \$75,600 (80%)





East Polk County Industrial Park
Purpose of study is to plan for future rail service on the East Polk County Industrial
Park site (plus, potentially on adjacent properties) as a railport, wind energy equipment distribution center, and a potential inland port.

Total Cost: \$125,000

Requested: \$100,000 (80%) Recommended: Not funded
