## Introduction and Credits

### INTRINSIC RESOURCES OF THE IOWA GREAT RIVER ROAD ARE WHY THE BYWAY HAS NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Intrinsic qualities and resources associated with the Iowa Great River Road National Scenic Byway are the visible and tangible resources that make this corridor special, unique and highly desirable to visit and experience.

Identifying intrinsic qualities associated with a byway is a condition of securing the byway's designation by the State of Iowa and the U.S. Secretary of Transportation. Conserving intrinsic resources of a Byway over time is a requirement for maintaining the state and federal byways designations. Perhaps most importantly, telling the stories associated with the intrinsic resources of a byway offers the most effective means to attract visitors and provides the basis for providing authentic and rewarding visitor and resident experiences.

Please refer to the Corridor Management Plan Library Document titled <u>Core Management Directions</u>, <u>Actions and Financial Considerations</u> for additional information for conserving, developing, promoting and interpreting the intrinsic resources of the lowa Great River Road.

This supplemental report presents a summary of the update and integration of various inventories of resources which have been assembled by various sources. Additionally, the intrinsic resource inventory that is now part of the 2015 Corridor Management Plan for the lowa Great River Road includes on-site observations made by members of the lowa Mississippi River Parkway Commission; the Commission's byway planning consultant, David L. Dahlquist Associates, Ankeny, Iowa; and many stakeholders from throughout the Byway's ten-county corridor.

The intrinsic resource inventory for the IAGRR exists in several digital forms. Over 500 sites are documented in an MS Excel spreadsheet and a PDF version is available. Additionally, ArcGIS shapefiles—digital files formatted for geographic information system (GIS) software—are available from the lowa Mississippi River Parkway Commission. A table listing intrinsic resource sites, visitor centers, Mississippi River access locations and supplemental





attractions is presented at the end of this report. Map atlases for each of the ten lowa Great River Road counties are provided separately.

### Corridor Management Plan Update

In December 2011, the Iowa Mississippi River Parkway Commission initiated a multi-year planning project to update the Corridor Management Plan (CMP) for the Iowa Great River Road. The project intends to aid the Commission in developing short, medium and long term goals, objectives and strategies for assuring that the Iowa Great River Road and its corridor of intrinsic resources provide the environment and experience that citizens and byway visitors seek and expect.

The opinions, findings, and conclusions expressed in this publication are those of the author and not necessarily those of the Iowa Department of Transportation or of the Federal Highway Administration.

## What are Intrinsic Qualities and Resources? Why are they important for the Iowa Great River Road?

## SIX COMMONLY ACCEPTED INTRINSIC QUALITIES FOR BYWAYS

An effective and widely accepted means of describing and categorizing the visual, tangible, and ephemeral characteristics of a byway is to identify its *intrinsic qualities and resources*. Six intrinsic qualities— archeological, cultural, historical, natural, recreational, and scenic—are valued qualities used to describe and categorize a byway's special sense of place and meaning to local residents and byway travelers alike. Furthermore, these six intrinsic qualities aid byway stakeholders and managers to determine, conserve, develop, interpret and promote the local, regional, and national significance of each individual site, event, and the stories they contribute to the authenticity of visitor experiences. In short, intrinsic qualities and resources are representative, unique, irreplaceable, or distinctive characteristics of the lowa Great River Road National Scenic Byway corridor.

Intrinsic qualities and resources are the important reasons for people to create and maintain emotional attachments to the landscape of the Mississippi River Valley and the lowa Great River Road, whether by living in the corridor of the Byway or by forming lifelong memories from leisure trips along the Mississippi River in Iowa.

Identified, categorized, and recorded, intrinsic resources have value because they can be enhanced, managed, protected, interpreted, and promoted. In other words, intrinsic resources can and should be recognized for reasons that:

- support visitor experience
- instill local resident values such as pride, investment and conservation of natural and historic resources
- aid in fulfilling state agency initiatives
- serve vital roles in communicating the stories that are regionally, nationally, and internationally significant



The existence of one or more intrinsic byway qualities; the resources sites which manifest those qualities; and their subsequent conservation and interpretation are used by the lowa Department of Transportation to designate Iowa Scenic and Heritage Byways and U.S. Secretary of Transportation to designate America's Byways. The Iowa Great River Road is one of more than ten Iowa Scenic and Heritage Byways and one of approximately 150 routes designated as an America's Byway.

### SCOPE OF THE INVENTORY OF INTRINSIC RESOURCES FOR THE IOWA GREAT RIVER ROAD

Inherently, documenting the intrinsic resources of rich byway corridors like that of the lowa Great River Road can become, in a way, an endless assignment. On one hand, the official state and federal designation of the byway implies that a certain 'threshold' of uniqueness, authenticity and repetitiveness be demonstrated for the byway. Yet, when we consider that intrinsic resources are the essence of what stakeholders use to manifest the visitor experience and livability of the corridor, where can lines really be drawn?

For purposes of the CMP, the documentation of the intrinsic resources provides an exploration of the diversity of what contributions to the lowa Great River Road's unique sense of place and potential for experiences. Even with more than 530 listings, it should be understood that the intrinsic resource inventory does not attempt to present an exhaustive or comprehensive tabulation of all existing intrinsic resources for the lowa Great River Road.

For example, the Iowa Great River Road relies on its many historic intrinsic resources and the 2015 Corridor Management Plan recognizes the importance of the nearly 600 properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places in the ten-county Iowa Great River Road corridor (approximately 30% of all properties listed from Iowa). For purposes of maintaining workability with the inventory of intrinsic resources for the Byway, only a fraction of the National Register of Historic Places are included in the GIS and spreadsheet versions. A current listing of the properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places is presented at the end of this report.



Similarly, the scenic resources of the Mississippi River Valley and the associated rural, urban and small town landscapes immerse nearly every mile of the lowa Great River Road. Documenting the location of every scenic view would be a daunting task and therefore the locations included in the inventory are a diverse representation of the landscape vantage points which travelers may enjoy and residents value.

Finally, certain intrinsic resources are actually in a multi-year process of development and their locations are in a continual state of expansion. The Mississippi River Trail (MRT) is identified as an important multi-county recreational intrinsic resource which is ultimately envisioned to parallel the entire length of the lowa Great River Road. For purposes of this current version of the intrinsic resource inventory for the Byway only the currently completed portions of the MTR are identified.

### SOURCES OF INFORMATION FOR THIS INVENTORY

The sources of information and data for the current inventory of Iowa Great River Road intrinsic resources include:

- Sites listed in the 2000 Corridor Management Plan for the Iowa Great River Road
- Suggestions provided by stakeholder representatives and meeting attendees
- Sites identified by members of the Iowa Mississippi River Parkway Commission circa 2010, complied with the assistance of the Northeast Iowa RC&D
- Field observations and recordings made by the David L. Dahlquist Associates Byway Planning team between 2010 and 2014
- The listing of tourism attractions developed by the Iowa Office of Tourism as of late 2014 (lodging, restaurant and events are not included in the Iowa Great River Road intrinsic resource inventory)
- Data secured from the Iowa Great River Road Reference Library
- A wide variety of websites hosted by public and private organizations located in eastern lowa
- Travel and visitor information guides produced by local communities



 Federal public lands management agencies including the National Park Service, US Fish and Wildlife Service, the US Army Corps of Engineers, and others

### USES OF THE INVENTORY OF INTRINSIC RESOURCES

The intrinsic resource inventory for the lowa Great River Road is prepared as a distinct or separable component of the overall 2015 Corridor Management Plan for the Byway. The inventory is intended to serve as a reference document for the lowa Mississippi River Parkway Commission but it offers a number of additional uses: As such, the tabular (spreadsheet) and cartographic / GIS format offer a variety of uses and benefits including but not limited to:

- 1. A benchmark of conditions at the time of preparing this update to the 2015 Corridor Management Plan for the Byway.
- The foundation for developing a recommended interpretive management plan for the lowa Great River Road which can assist with more effective communication of the themes and stories of the Byway.
- 3. Information for groups and organizations concerned with resource protection and conservation.
- 4. Information which may supplement primary and secondary education programs and classes.
- 5. A source of data for expanding the listings of attractions offered by the lowa Office of Tourism on the website for the lowa Great River Road: <a href="https://www.iowagreatriverroad.com">www.iowagreatriverroad.com</a>.
- 6. Information that can assist organizations in the promotion of travel and tourism destinations in eastern lowa.
- 7. A reference of data for state, county and municipal planning staff and officials in assessing impacts of public works and private development proposals and projects.
- 8. Support for programs to promote and educate the public as well as public officials regarding the value of the National tenstate Great River Road.
- 9. A basis for designating the Iowa Great River Road as an "All-American Road" by the U.S. Secretary of Transportation.



It is recommended that the intrinsic resource inventory for the lowa Great River Road be updated every five years to maintain the accuracy and relevancy of the database.



## Intrinsic Qualities and Resources of the Iowa Great River Road

Intrinsic qualities refer to what is representative, unique, irreplaceable, or distinctly characteristic about a byway. To achieve and sustain designation as an official state or national scenic byway, the corridor surrounding the byway route needs to convincingly exhibit one or more of these qualities: scenic, natural, historic, archeological, cultural, and recreational, and resources.

A byway corridor management plan typically includes an inventory of representative intrinsic resources—specific locations—which provide the tangible authenticity that substantiates the presence of one or several intrinsic qualities. A corridor management plan also includes a discussion of the needs and opportunities to conserve, develop, interpret and promote, and manage the byway's intrinsic qualities.

The lowa Great River Road possesses features representing the six intrinsic qualities. The following types of resources appear to make the strongest contribution to creating the unique appeal of the lowa Great River Road. For reference, the colored circular symbols correlate with the symbols associated with resource sites in the intrinsic resource inventory map atlases.





### **Scenic Intrinsic Quality**

Scenic Quality is the heightened visual experience derived from the view of natural and manmade elements of the visual environment of the scenic byway corridor. The characteristics of the landscape are strikingly distinct and offer a pleasing and most memorable visual experience. All elements of the landscape—landform, water, vegetation, and manmade development—contribute to the quality of the corridor's visual environment. The visual character of places along the byway are in harmony and share in the intrinsic qualities.

For the Iowa Great River Road, examples of scenic qualities include:

- The Mississippi River itself
- Dramatic bluff land views and vistas
- Rock outcroppings
- Agricultural fields, farmsteads
- Distinctive architecture
- Small town main streets
- Vegetation of the fall and spring seasons
- Winter scenes with fresh snow
- Upland and floodplain forests
- Tributary rivers and streams, wetlands and backwaters
- Diverse topography
- Narrow channel and wide channel diversity

Approximately 95 scenic resource sites along the Iowa Great River Road are listed in the inventory.






Figure 1 Scenic bluffs along the Great River Road in Allamakee County.

### **Natural Intrinsic Quality**

Natural Quality applies to those features in the visual environment that are in a relatively undisturbed state. These features predate the arrival of human populations and may include geological formations, fossils, landform, water bodies, vegetation, and wildlife. There may be evidence of human activity, but the natural features reveal minimal disturbances.

For the lowa Great River Road, examples of natural qualities include:

- Geology, landforms and river hydrology
- Diverse wildlife including bald eagles
- Caves and natural springs
- Mississippi River tributary crossings and river level fluctuations
- Upper Mississippi National Wildlife and Fish Refuge
- Mark Twain National Wildlife Refuge
- Protected wildlife management properties, state preserves
- State, county and city parks
- Nature centers, interpretation programs and watchable wildlife programs and opportunities

Approximately 60 natural resource sites along the lowa Great River Road are listed in the inventory.

### **Historic Intrinsic Quality**

Historic Quality encompasses legacies of the past that are distinctly associated with physical elements of the landscape, whether natural or manmade, that are of such historic significance that they educate the viewer and stir an appreciation for the past. The historic elements reflect the actions of people and may include buildings, settlement patterns, and other examples of human activity. Historic features can be inventoried, mapped, and interpreted. They possess integrity of location, design, setting, material, workmanship, feeling, and association.

For the Iowa Great River Road, examples of historic qualities include:

- National Register of Historic Districts
- National Register of Historic Places
- Historic vehicle and railroad bridges
- Century Farms and classic farm buildings
- Railroad routing, depots and structures
- Locks and Dams of the Mississippi River adjoining Iowa
- Historic cemeteries
- City and county historical museums
- Historic factory buildings, docks, commercial buildings, brewery buildings
- Country schools and small town school buildings
- Churches
- Riverfront parks
- Mormon Trail route
- Pedestrian walkways, stairs and elevators set in the bluff faces of towns and cities
- Historic markers

Approximately 130 historic resource sites along the lowa Great River Road are listed in the inventory.

### **Archaeological Intrinsic Quality**

Archaeological Quality involves those characteristics of the byway corridor that are physical evidence of historic or prehistoric human life or activity that are visible and capable of being inventoried and interpreted. The byway corridor's archeological interest, as identified through ruins, artifacts, structural remains, and other physical evidence have scientific significance that educate the viewer and stir an appreciation for the past.

For the Iowa Great River Road, archeological resources include:

- Effigy Mounds National Monument
- Toolesboro Indian Mounds National Historic Landmark
- Various officially identified and protected archeological sites
- Protected native American sites
- Museums and artifacts

Five archeological resource sites along the Iowa Great River Road are listed in the inventory.










Figure 8 Toolesboro Mound Group National Historic Landmark in Louisa County.





### **Cultural Intrinsic Quality**

Cultural Quality is evidence and expressions of the customs or traditions of a distinct group of people that are still currently practiced. Cultural features include but are not limited to crafts, music, dance, rituals, festivals, speech, food, special events, and vernacular architecture.

For the Iowa Great River Road, examples of cultural qualities include:

- All towns and cities along the lowa Great River Road
- Various ethnic and community festivals and events
- Farmers markets
- Iowa Main Street Program districts
- Art galleries
- Music performance venues featuring locally-based artists
- Wineries
- Restaurants featuring locally-grown food and immigrant/ethnic food
- Mississippi River commercial barge and recreational boat traffic particularly associated with all locks and dams

Nearly 80 cultural resource sites along the lowa Great River Road are listed in the inventory.

### **Recreational Intrinsic Quality**

Recreational Quality involves outdoor recreational activities directly associated with and dependent upon the natural and cultural elements of the corridor's landscape. The recreational activities provide opportunities for active and passive recreational experiences. They include but are not limited to downhill skiing, rafting, boating, fishing, and hiking. The recreational activities may be seasonal, but the quality and importance of the recreational activities as seasonal operations must be well recognized.

For the Iowa Great River Road, examples of recreational qualities include:

- Water-based recreation opportunities for boating, fishing, hunting
- Developed recreation access areas of the Upper Mississippi River National Wildlife and Fish Refuge, the Mark Twain National Wildlife Refuge and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- Protected wildlife management properties, state preserves
- State, county and city parks
- Nature centers
- Many types of hiking and bicycling trails including the Mississippi River Trail
- Primitive and modern campgrounds
- Wildlife viewing
- Antique and art shopping
- Performing arts and cultural events
- Art museums

Approximately 200 recreational resource sites along the lowa Great River Road are listed in the inventory.

# Mapping of Representative Intrinsic Resources for the Ten-County Iowa Great River Road Corridor


An important aspect of maintaining the record of representative intrinsic resources of the lowa Great River Road is that of the mapping or cartography of the resources sites. Visualizing the location of the resource relative to the designated route, political boundaries and numerous landscape features such as land uses, rivers, waterbodies, transportation systems and features helps a variety of audiences understand the importance of such resources. For this purpose, geographic information system (GIS) software and procedures are used to manage data and produce graphic map products. Current aerial photography provides a useful reference background. GIS functions provides up-to-date latitude and longitude coordinates for each individual intrinsic resource site.

A map atlas for each of the ten Iowa Great River Road counties has been prepared. PDF files of the map atlases along with GIS geo-data files are available from the Iowa Mississippi River Parkway Commission at <a href="https://www.iowadot.gov/iowasbyways/IAGRR-CMP.html">www.iowadot.gov/iowasbyways/IAGRR-CMP.html</a> and by downloading files from the Document Library of <a href="https://www.DDAForum.com">www.DDAForum.com</a>.

# Tabulation of Representative Intrinsic Resources of the Ten Iowa Great River Road Counties

This section presents a tabular listing of the representative intrinsic resources located in the ten-county corridor of the lowa Great River Road. The table lists nearly 540 locations, areas, and points. If a particular resource such as the Upper Mississippi River National Wildlife Refuge and Fish Refuge or the Mississippi River Trail spans or occurs in multiple counties, the resource is listed in each county it occurs. The table is organized by county starting with Allamakee County in the north and continues to Lee County in the south.

The intrinsic resource inventory contains the following attributes:

- 1. <u>ID Code</u>: A unique identification code assigned to each resource use only for purpose of this inventory.
- 2. Resource / Attraction Name: Commonly identified name for the resource.
- 3. <u>City</u>: Name of the town or city in which the resource is located or is near.
- 4. County: County in which the resource is located.
- 5. <u>Latitude</u>: Approximate indicator of the resource's distance north of the equator (Geographic Coordinate System) expressed in decimal degrees (DD) according to the standards for World Geodetic Systems (WGS 84).
- 6. <u>Longitude</u>: Approximate indicator of the resource's distance from west of the Prime Meridian expressed in decimal degrees (DD) according to the standards for World Geodetic Systems (WGS 84).
- 7. <u>Iowa Great River Road Intrinsic Qualities</u>: "Yes" indicates that the Resource / Attraction exhibits or possesses characteristics that can be considered supportive of the respective intrinsic quality.
- 8. <u>A Designated National Great River Road Interpretive Center</u>: "Yes" indicates that the resource is designated an "Interpretative Center" by the national Mississippi River Parkway Commission.
- 9. <u>Interpretive Communication provided at this Facility</u>: "Yes" indicates that the resource likely provides interpretive communications media ranging from fixed exhibits to interpreter-led programs.
- 10. <u>Visitor Information provided at this Facility</u>: "Yes" indicates that the location likely provides travel and tourism information to people who visit the location.
- 11. <u>Mississippi River can be reached or seen from this Location</u>: "Yes" indicates the resource exists in close proximity to the shore of the Mississippi River either physically or visually.



- 12. <u>Supplemental Attraction or Point of Interest</u>: "Yes" indicates that the attraction appears to have characteristics which can supplement the experience of exploring the Iowa Great River Road. Attractions with this indication are primarily those included in the Iowa Office of Tourism inventory but which may appropriately not be consistent with definitions associated with byway designation.
- 13. <u>Included in 2014 Iowa Tourism Office Inventory of Attractions</u>: "Yes" indicates that the resource/attraction was listed in the 2014 edition of attractions by the Iowa Office of Tourism.
- 14. <u>Included in 2000 IA GRR CMP list of Intrinsic Resources</u>: "Yes" indicates that the resource was indicated as an intrinsic resource in the original Corridor Management Plan prepared for the Iowa Great River Road in 2000.
