Local Public Agency and Consultant Partners,

As you all likely know, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) was signed into law on November 15, 2021. The IIJA offers numerous discretionary grant opportunities. Among those are some new grants. For example, the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the Department of Transportation's Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant Opportunity has been released and can be found [here](#).

In order to provide stakeholders with more visibility into upcoming funding opportunities, DOT has published a [list of anticipated dates for Notice of Funding Opportunities \(NOFOs\)](#) for key Bipartisan Infrastructure Law programs. We at Iowa DOT are not the contact for these grant opportunities, but we did want to share the information since it crossed our desks.

Please note any funds being utilized as "non-Federal match" included in a grant application must also follow federal-aid processes and procedures.
