



# **BICYCLING RULES OF THE ROAD**



RIDE ONLY WHERE PERMITTED Bicyclists are allowed on almost all lowa roads except for interstates, highways with posted minimum speed limits, and streets where bicyclists are prohibited by local ordinance.

**OBEY ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS, SIGNALS,** AND LANE MARKINGS



**ALWAYS RIDE WITH THE FLOW OF** TRAFFIC AND ON THE RIGHT Ride in the right lane, except when passing another vehicle, preparing for a left turn, or avoiding hazards.



**PASS ON THE LEFT** Always pass a vehicle or bicycle on the left. First move to the left lane. After overtaking the vehicle, return to the right lane once reaching a safe and clear distance in front of the vehicle.



SIGNAL YOUR INTENTIONS WHEN TURNING OR STOPPING Use your left hand to signal when you plan to turn, change lanes, or stop.




