

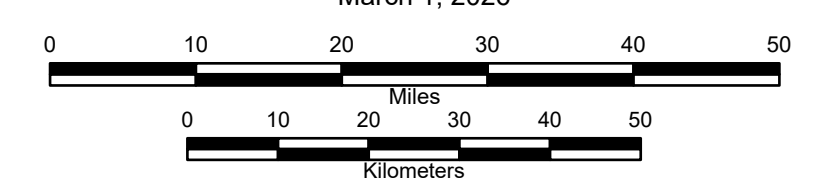
PRIMARY ROAD SURFACE WIDTH AND VERTICAL CLEARANCE

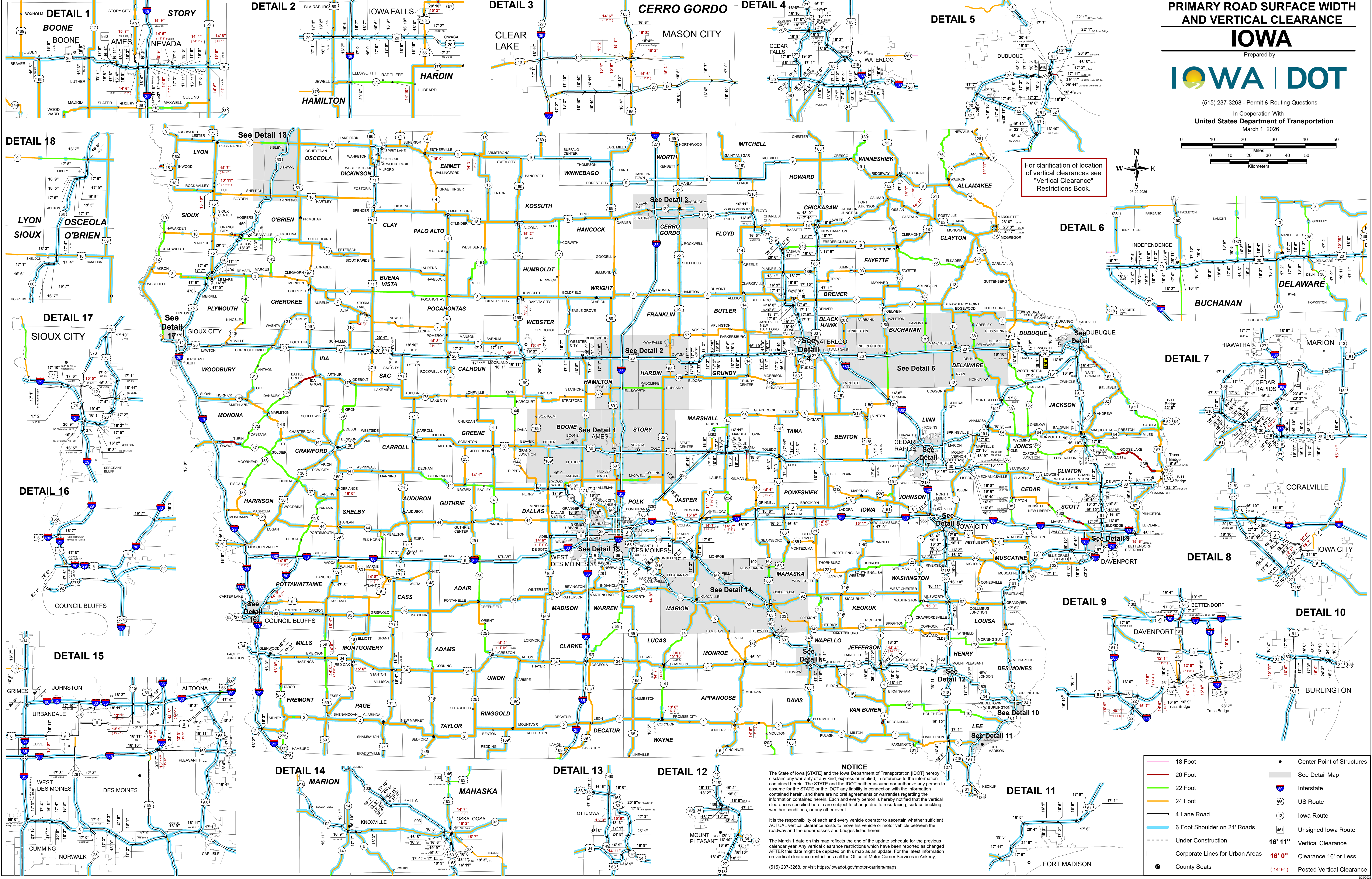
