- Available to cities, counties, state agencies, local governments, or non-profit organizations through an application program
- Purpose is to establish recreational trails in Iowa for the use, enjoyment and participation of the public.

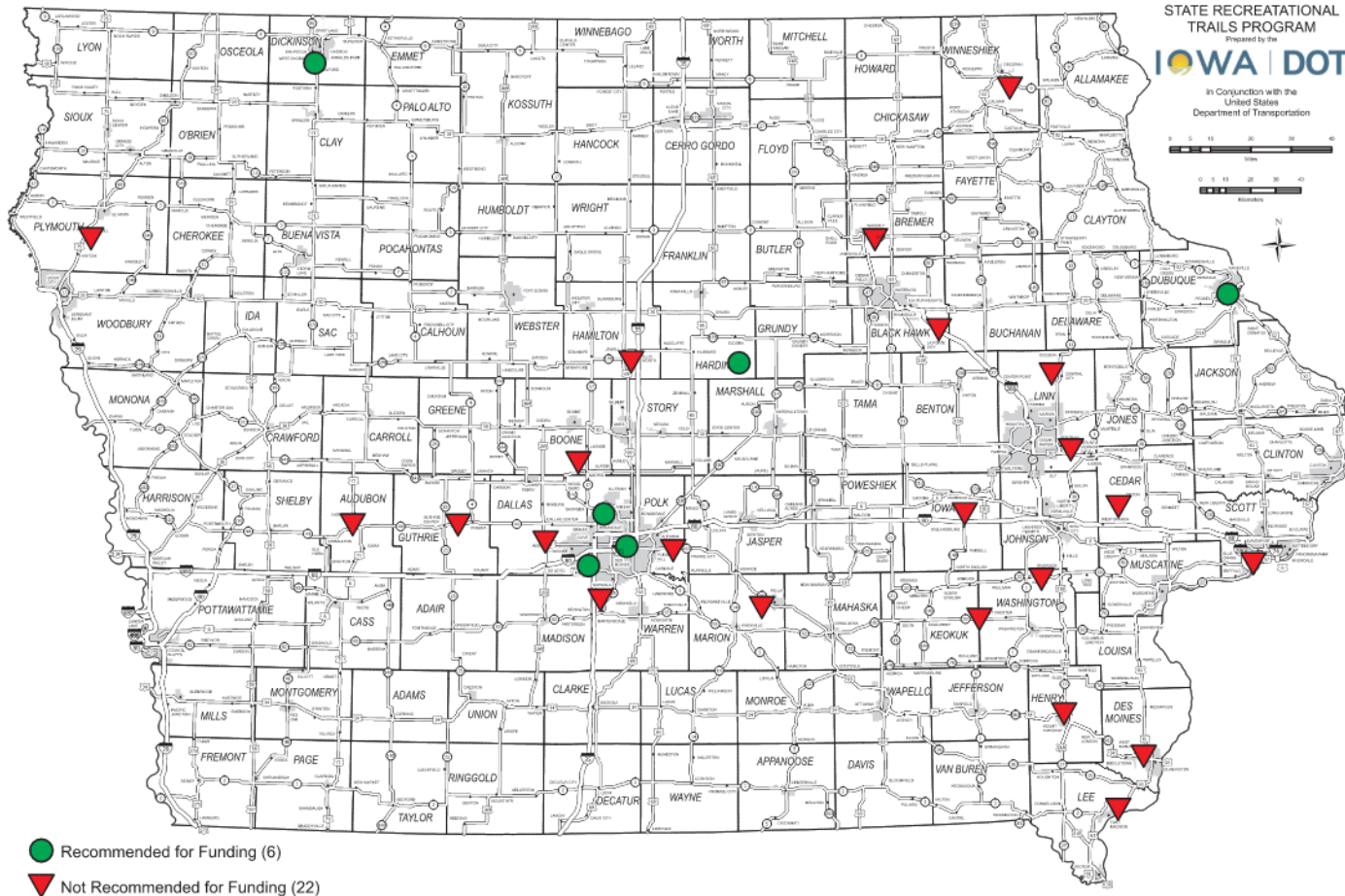

Central Place Trail Phase 2 (Des Moines)

Construct 1.8 miles of paved trail from Franklin Avenue and 2nd Avenue through Prospect Park and the Ding Darling Greenway connecting to the Central Iowa Trail network, the Iowa Confluence Water Trails network and the American Discovery Trail. Project also includes construction of direct neighborhood access to these networks.

Total Cost: \$4,130,000

Requested: \$470,000 (11%)



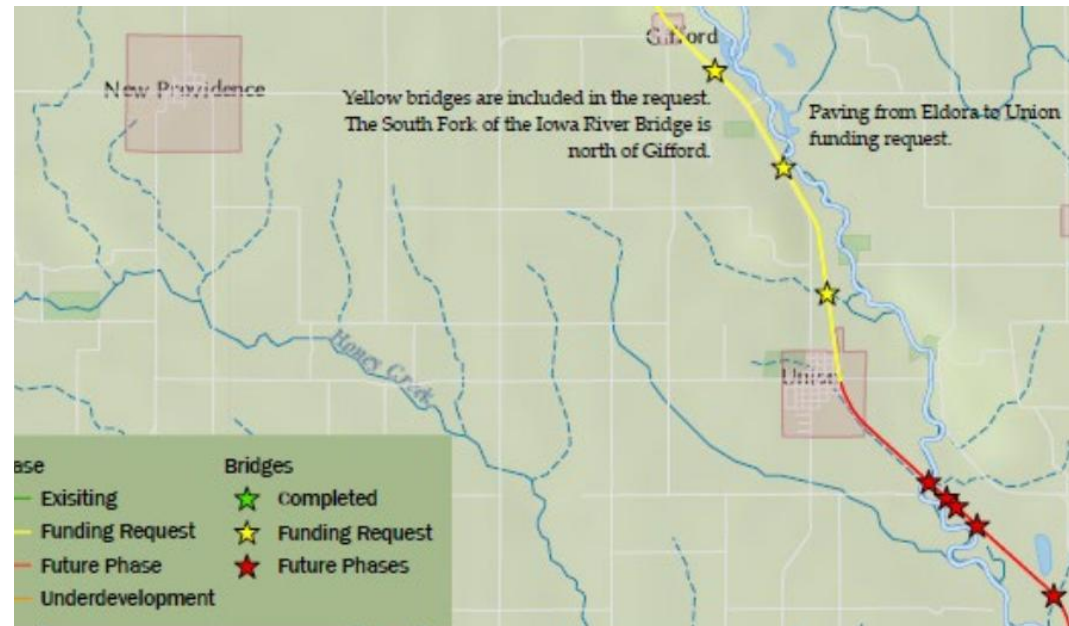

Iowa River's Edge Trail Resurfacing & Bridge Replacement between Gifford and Union (Hardin County)

Paving 3.6 miles of granular trail and reconstruct three bridges between Gifford and Union. This project is part of the Great American Rail Trail, a planned 3,700-mile coast-to-coast trail from Washington, D.C., to Washington state.

Total Cost: \$1,986,747

Requested: \$413,119 (21%)

Raccoon River East Greenway Trail: 1st Street Recreation Area to Raccoon River Park (West Des Moines)

Construct 1.3 miles of paved trail from the 1st Street Recreation Area to Raccoon River Park along the Raccoon River Greenway. Project also includes construction of 100' long trail bridge over Jordan Creek. Project is part of the 26.2-mile Marathon Loop Trail and part of the city's Five Waters Project Initiative.

Total Cost: \$1,925,000

Requested: \$400,000 (21%)

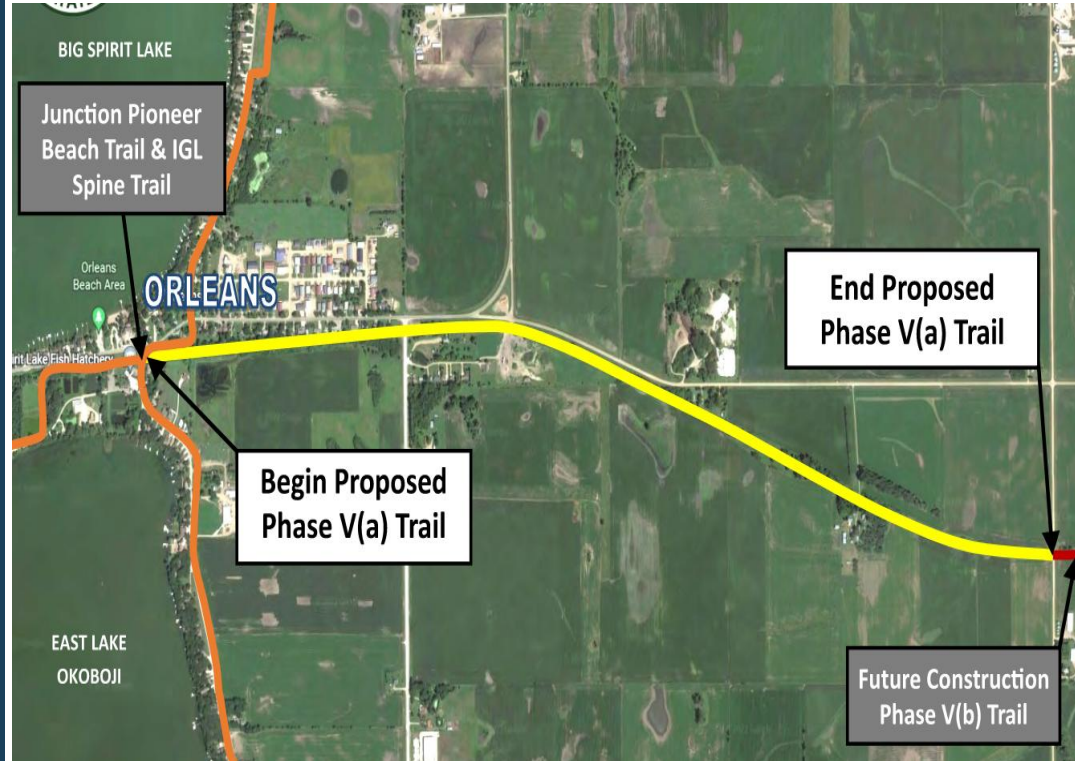
Tatanka Ska Trace Phase 5a (Dickinson County)

Constructs 2.2 miles of paved trail between 252nd Avenue in Orleans and 270th Avenue. This segment expands the existing 37-mile Tatanka Ska Trace Trail and connects to the Pioneer Beach Trail and Iowa Great Lakes Spine Trail networks.

Total Cost: \$1,033,178

Requested: \$535,000 (52%)

Recommended: \$475,000 (46%)

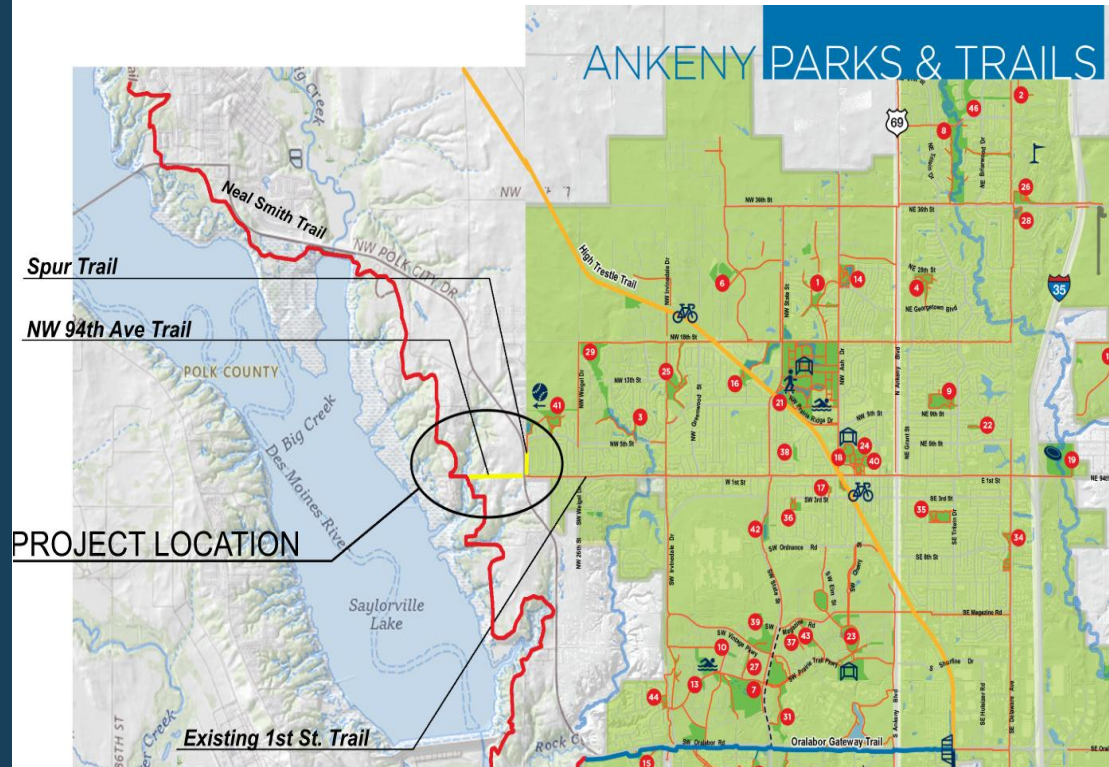
Neal Smith Trail Connection: NW 94th Avenue (Polk County Conservation Board)

Constructs 0.5 miles of paved trail starting at Iowa 415 filling the gap between 1st Street Trail and the Neal Smith Trail, connecting at the Cherry Glenn Campground at Saylorville Lake. An additional 0.09 miles of paved trail will be added along Iowa 415 to connect to the existing neighborhood park trail.

Total Cost: \$831,000

Requested: \$623,250 (75%)

Recommended: \$400,000 (48%)

White Street Two-Way Bicycle Track: 5th Street to 19th Street (Dubuque)

Project creates a grade-separated bike facility of 0.85 miles stretching from 5th Street to 19th Street. Track will run adjacent to a 6' sidewalk and a 5' buffer between the street to improve safety for cyclists, pedestrians and motorists.

Total Cost: \$2,900,000

Requested: \$500,000 (17%)

Recommended: \$398,936 (14%)
