	Bridge	-Percentage of NHS bridges classified as in Good condition -Percentage of NHS bridges classified as in Poor condition	
PM3	System Performance	-Percent of person-miles traveled on the Interstate that are reliable -Percent of person-miles traveled on the non-Interstate NHS that are reliable

- MPOs/RPAs can utilize STBG; LPAs would utilize local funds.
- MPOs/RPAs should make this a regular consideration in their TIP development cycle.

## Upcoming Items

- TPWP
  - Work program guidelines will be reviewed for changes and will be sent to agencies in January 2023.
  - SFY 2024 draft planning funding targets will be sent to the agencies for budgeting purposes in February 2023.
  - Draft TPWPs should be submitted to the Iowa DOT no later than April 1, 2023.

## Upcoming Items

- PTP
  - Draft PTP is due February 1;
  - DOT comments returned by April 1;
  - Final PTP is due May 1.
  - Agencies with PTPs due in CY 2023
    - RPA 1, RPA 9/BiState, RPA 11/DMAMPO, RPA 13/18, RPA 15, MAPA.
  - Agencies with PTPs due in CY 2024
    - RPA 12, RPA 4/SIMPACO, RPA 6, AAMPO, CMPO
