SUBJECT

This informational memo explains legislation enacted during the 2018 legislative session regarding continuation of the authority for certain qualifying lowa-based motor carriers to conduct commercial driver's license (CDL) skills tests.

SUMMARY

To overcome commercial driver shortages and meet ongoing demand for well-qualified commercial drivers, some lowa-based motor carriers implemented commercial driver training programs to recruit, develop and employ new commercial drivers. In 2014, the legislature helped these carriers more quickly and effectively license and employ students in their programs by authorizing the carriers to administer the CDL skills test to their students. However, the authorization to do that was set to expire May 14, 2019. House File 2197, enacted during the 2018 legislative session removed the 2019 expiration date from Iowa law, which allows these motor carriers to continue conducting CDL skills tests for the foreseeable future. **This legislation is effective July 1, 2018.**

CURRENT

Under previous lowa session law, the authorization for lowa-based motor carriers to conduct CDL skills tests was set to expire May 14, 2019.

NEW

Under new Iowa session law, the 2019 expiration date was removed from Iowa law.

BUSINESS IMPACT

The legislation continues the current practice of allowing certain qualifying lowa-based motor carriers to conduct CDL skills tests and does not cause any change in processes or procedures for DIS staff. We currently have two lowa-based motor carriers approved to perform CDL skills-testing, which are CRST in Cedar Rapids and TMC in Ankeny.
