

Motor Vehicle Division Informational Memo # 20-01 Electronic Application for Duplicate Credential Upon Attaining Age 21 Administrative Rule Updates

SUBJECT

This informational memo explains an update to administrative rule chapters 761—605, License Issuance and 761—630, Non-Operator's Identification.

SUMMARY

The updates to these rule chapters align with a change to Iowa Code section 321.189 made during the 2019 legislative session, which provided the ability for a customer attaining the age of 21 to apply electronically for a duplicate driver's license or non-operator's identification card for the unexpired months of the credential. The purpose of the legislation was to make it easier for a customer attaining age 21 to obtain a duplicate credential because that is the age when the license or ID card can be issued with a horizontal rather than a vertical orientation and is when the credential is no longer required to contain the phrase "under 21."

The administrative rule amendments are effective February 5, 2020.

CURRENT

Previously, we did not offer the ability for a customer to apply electronically for a duplicate driver's license or non-operator's identification card, regardless of the customer's age, however, a customer could obtain a duplicate license or ID card by visiting a driver's license issuance location or self-serve kiosk. Only a renewal of the license could be done electronically through the MyMVD website.

As of February 5, 2020, the rules will align with Iowa Code section 321.189 and our current processes for allowing a customer to electronically apply for a duplicate license or ID card upon attaining age 21.
