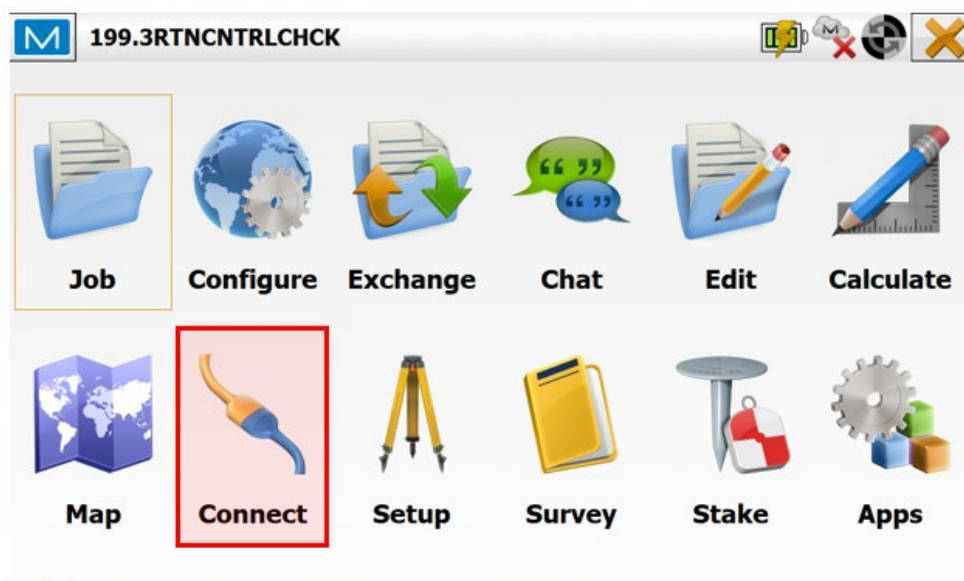
5. On the Tracking screen check on the constellations that are available according to your equipment.

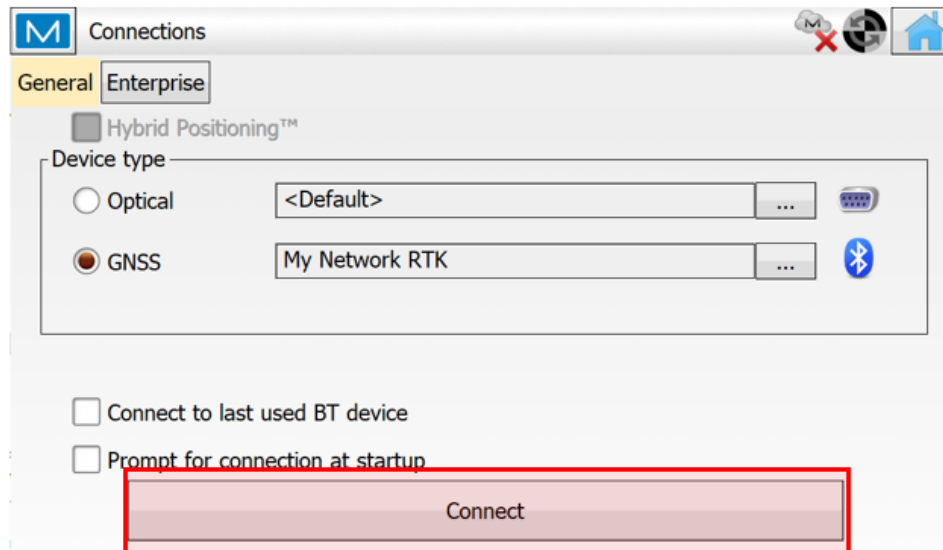


6. Click Next through the last windows or click the green check mark in the top right corner to finish the set up.
