

CID Total Passengers (CY 1947 - 2021)






IOWA FLIES CID CID 2021 passengers



Route Map
















CID Terminal Modernization - Phase 1





CID Terminal Modernization - Phase 2




Terminal Modernization Project Phase 2 = \$13,255,589



Phase 2: Complete transformation of the public space in the non-secure areas of the terminal building to include renovation of rental car and airport shuttle counters, baggage claim equipment, the checkpoint entry, expanded ticket counter space, adding skylights for more natural lighting/energy savings, and updates to the heating and cooling systems.



Phase 3: Start of the security and post-security transformation with an expansion of the checkpoint and holdroom space by 54,350 square feet, to include additional restrooms, energy efficient roofing and siding, geothermal HVAC system, including well field, and 240 KWh solar array. This phase also included the addition of two additional concession areas providing enhanced services for passengers.


