Title Revitalize Iowa's Sound Economy (RISE) Application – Clinton					

#### DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND:

The city of Clinton submitted a RISE Immediate Opportunity application requesting a grant to assist in construction of approximately 4,650 feet of 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue South located on the southwest side of town.

Because this project will provide improved access to Lincolnway Industrial Rail and Air Park, an Iowa Economic Development Authority certified site of more than 375 acres, and to maximize RISE support for this project, staff evaluated the application as an Iowa's Certified Site Program RISE Local Development project. The certification for this site expires April 14, 2028.

The evaluation and rating for the project will be discussed.

#### PROPOSAL/ACTION RECOMMENDATION:

Director

It is recommended the Commission, based on the capital investment commitment and potential for future job creation, reclassify the project as an Iowa's Certified Site Program RISE Local Development project in the February 2023 round of applications and award a RISE grant from the city share of the RISE Fund. The estimated total RISE-eligible project cost is \$4,866,250 and the estimated RISE grant is \$2,919,750 or up to 60 percent of the total RISE-eligible project cost, whichever is less. Since this is a certified site project, the actual award amount is subject to change as the project plans are finalized. Any changes to the scope or approved funding will be submitted by the department to the Commission for consideration as a modification to the award.

Revitalize Iowa's Sound Economy (RISE) Application – Grimes					

#### DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND:

The city of Grimes submitted a RISE Local Development application in the February 2023 round requesting a grant to assist in construction of approximately 945 feet of SE Park Drive and 790 feet of SE 40<sup>th</sup> Street located on the south side of town.

This project is necessary to provide improved access to three lots totaling more than 57 acres for office, distribution, and warehousing purposes. This project is anticipated to be completed by May 2025.

The evaluation and rating for the project will be discussed.

#### PROPOSAL/ACTION RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the Commission, based on the capital investment commitment and potential for future job creation, award a RISE grant of \$1,033,391 or up to 50 percent of the total RISE-eligible project cost, whichever is less, from the city share of the RISE Fund.
