We will use "CC" throughout for Contiguous County.

Standard title & registration transaction in ARTS


- Most elements of a title & registration transaction will not look any different in ARTS
- Customer at any Priority level (1, 2 or 3) needs to be a resident or CC
- Make sure customer understands that the plate and the title will be issued by the county where it is transacted
- Make sure to set which customer will get renewals as that will determine Managing County

If no customer is resident or CC ...

- Check to see if any customer has a new address that would make them a resident or CC; update Customer Record and Update deal
- If you do not have a customer that is resident or CC, then refuse the deal, return the application materials and direct customer to a different county
 - Please advise customer to complete a new application;
 customer should not cross out CC information at bottom
 and write in a new county

Three discretionary errors may fire for CC

DE27 – transaction being performed in wrong county
 This is OK if you confirm it is a Contiguous County
 Clerk may auto approve



Three discretionary errors may fire for CC

DE58 – plate does not match managing county
 This is OK if you confirm it is a Contiguous County
 Clerk may auto approve


Three discretionary errors may fire for CC

- DE867 transaction being performed in county not contiguous
 THIS IS YOUR FATAL ERROR DO NOT PROCEED
- Go back and check everything that might make it eligible for CC or resident county.
- Do not proceed with an unresolved DE867. Cancel the deal, return materials to customer and advise that they will need to be revised and submitted to eligible county.


Transaction coming from ERT

 General queue reminder that transactions do not immediately display. You must set options and hit "Refresh" when you open the queue



Transaction coming from ERT

You can sort and limit based on the available options




Checking ERT for resident or CC customer

- This is essentially the same as checking for resident or CC customer for a paper deal
- ARTS will display the same DE's upon validation if there is no customer qualifying as resident or CC
- Check application paperwork to see if customer is requesting an updated address; update in Customer record and Update Deal
 - If you do not Update Deal, the change may not take effect and you may not properly route the fees to your County
- Reminder that with the new T&R form, a separate ERT authorization is no longer required (if ERT box is checked)

Denial in ERT

- If ERT deal has no resident or CC customer, DE867 fires
 - Deny deal and state "No resident or contiguous county customer" or similar statement in comments.

Help

Accounting

- There are no changes. Money from a CC customer is treated the same as money from a resident customer.
- If transaction fires DE867, do not proceed and do not collect money. We do not recommend endorsing a check to a different county because the customer still has a choice of where to submit the application.
- Please assist both resident and CC customers with refunds if they pertain to the original title transaction in your county.

Using the new title & reg application forms

- On or after February 24, 2022, an applicant may use the legacy forms but <u>only</u> in the county of residence
 - Separate ERT authorization would be required
 - Remind applicant / dealer of new forms
- A contiguous county applicant <u>must</u> use the new form
- ARTS Print App will reflect the new forms
- Please remind dealers and applicants of new "explanation" section on page 3. This is far better for dealers than adding handwritten notes in margins.

Anticipated questions

Q – what happens if we send a DE867 to MVD for review?

A – MVD will deny it and return it to the county. The DE867 should be considered a fatal error. We may investigate to see if the county missed a customer address change, but the county will need to make that change.

Q – what if optional county name on plate is passed?

A – That is a different issue entirely. It will require ARTS programming changes and likely another update to the application forms.

Q – can we turn away a contiguous county customer?

A – No. Iowa Code 321.20(4) specifically allows the application to be made to a contiguous county.

Anticipated questions

Q - what outreach are we making

A – IADA has been fully engaged and is aware

A – We are reaching out to IIADA and out-of-state dealer associations to inform them of the change and the new forms

A – While we are making updates to our Web pages and the forms on Seamless, we are not doing any social media posts or promotions of the change.
