Be sure to bring the following items in order to take the drive test and apply for the intermediate or minor school license.
 The student's lowa instruction permit Proof of insurance for the vehicle that will be used during the drive test Cash/Check/Debit for the \$8.00 (plus processing) license fee Signed Minor School License Affidavit (lowa DOT form number 430021), if applying for a minor school license If you or another parent/legal custodian does not accompany the student, the student must also bring a parental consent form (lowa DOT form number 430018) to the issuance location.
