## ON THE PROPOSED CULVERT REPAIRS ON U.S. 59 IN CRAWFORD COUNTY

The Iowa Department of Transportation is requesting public input for a proposed culvert repairs under U.S. 59 south of Denison. The project includes repairing roadway concrete pipe culverts in five locations from 1.45 miles north of Crawford County Road E-59 to 1.5 miles north of Crawford County Road E-53. Some locations will require additional right of way for the culverts and drainage. Construction of the project is expected to begin in 2022.
