



PUBLIC INPUT REQUESTED

ON INTERSTATE 80 IN CEDAR COUNTY

The Iowa Department of Transportation is requesting public input for proposed improvements to I-80 from Cedar County Road X-52/Pine Avenue to 0.7 miles west of U.S. 6 at Sugar Creek. This project involves the replacement of the I-80 eastbound and westbound bridges over Sugar Creek, 1.5 miles west of the east junction of Iowa 38. The bridges have reached the end of their service life and are ready to be replaced. The bridges will be raised so adjacent sections of I-80 will be reconstructed to meet the elevation of the new bridges.
