The lowa Department of Transportation is requesting public input for proposed work at the Ridgeway Avenue intersection on lowa 27/lowa 58 from south of the eastbound ramps to north of Ridgeway Avenue in Cedar Falls in Black Hawk County. The project also includes widening of the eastbound entrance ramp at the lowa 27 and U.S. 20 interchange.
