Infrastructure

The Iowa Department of Transportation (Iowa DOT) is implementing a new vision for the I-380 Corridor between Cedar Rapids and Iowa City. This plan provides investments now while preparing for the future. In addition to the reconstruction of the I-80/I-380 Interchange, it includes the future widening and modernization of I-380 between the metro areas. But as commuter travel continues to grow, a more comprehensive system is needed.

The I-380 Vision includes Integrated Corridor Management (ICM) measures to maximize the benefits of highway widening and provide more mobility options for commuters, now and into the future. Implementation of these measures during the I-80/I-380 Interchange reconstruction is an opportunity to demonstrate the benefits of non-highway improvements and support long-term funding by the region.

REGIONAL CARPOOL AND VANPOOL PILOT PROGRAM

Let someone else drive. A new and expanded
ridesharing program is underway, providing
commuters options for traveling.

How it Works – Participants are matched with others having similar daily commutes to share a ride to work or school:



Carpool - Commuters travel together in personal vehicles and share in the costs.



Vanpool - Between 5 and 12 commuters travel together in a fully equipped passenger van provided by the program and pay for the service monthly.

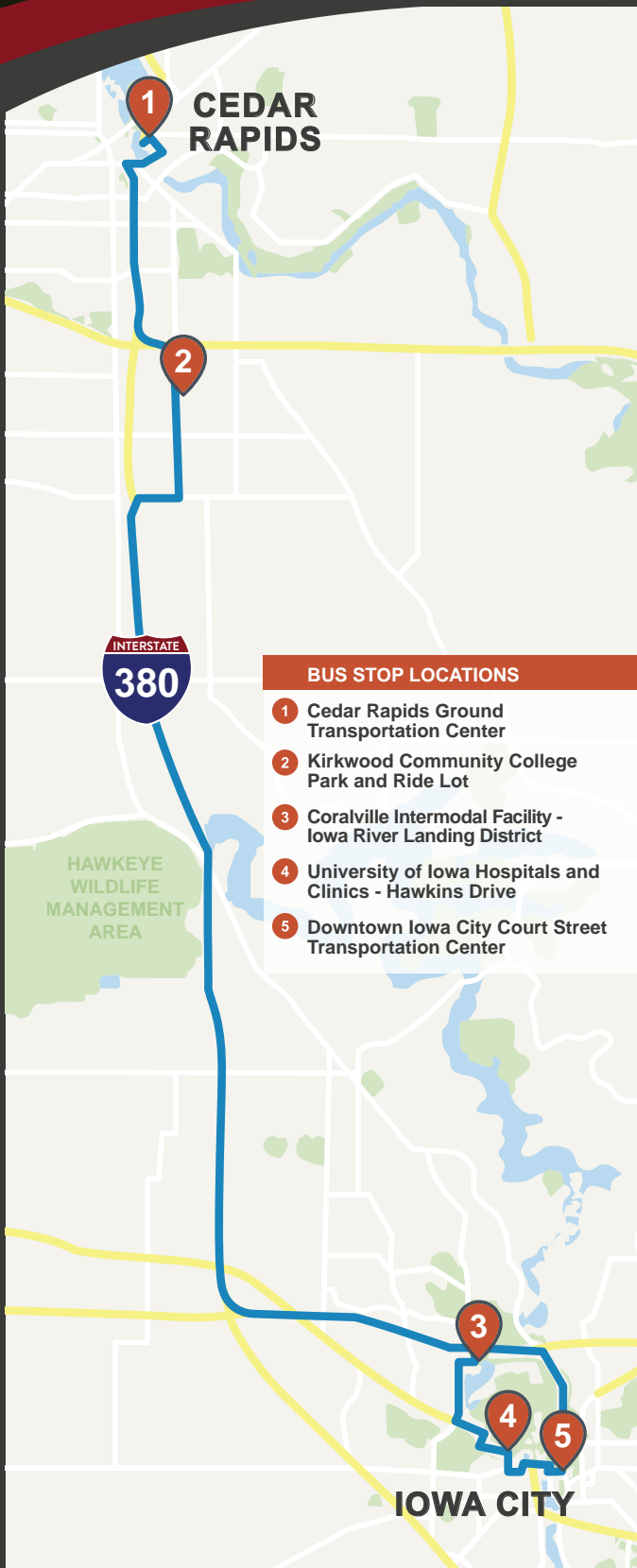

INTERREGIONAL EXPRESS BUS PILOT PROGRAM

Let someone else drive. New express bus service connecting downtown Cedar Rapids and Iowa City is available, providing commuters a travel option.

Schedule – Every Monday through Friday, buses operate every half hour during the morning and afternoon commuter periods and every hour during the mid-day. Connections to other bus routes are available at the transportation centers.
