The lowa Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting Wednesday, November 6th, 2019, to discuss an Interstate 380 corridor study from south of U.S. 30 in Cedar Rapids to north of Forevergreen Road in North Liberty. Proposed improvements include widening I-380 to six lanes, active lane management considerations, and proposed interchange improvements at Penn Street, 120th Street, and Wright Brothers Boulevard.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting between 5 and 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.
