

Reports or Studies Required by the 80th General Assembly, 2004 Session, Which Affect the Department of Transportation

The following requires the DOT to assist with a study and report:

HF 2433 Section 2 requires the state auditor, in consultation with the DOT and the Iowa State County Treasurers Association, to conduct a study of the fiscal impact of the county driver's license issuance program and report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly prior to January 1, 2006. This study must be repeated every four years thereafter.

The following are of interest to the DOT:

SF 2298 Section 342 extends the deadline until December 1, 2004, for the Department of Administrative Services, with the assistance of the Department of Management, to complete the study of merging the state's data centers and workforce.

SR 175 This senate resolution requests that the Legislative Council establish a study committee to meet during the 2004 legislative interim to consider options for using renewable energy for economic development. This committee should also focus on electricity generation, co-generation and use of ethanol and alternative fuels.
