

SF 2394 DOT Appropriations

The FY 2009 Transportation Appropriations Act, SF 2394, appropriates \$328.1 million to the DOT, including \$47.7 million from the Road Use Tax Fund, \$280.4 million from the Primary Road Fund, and 3,373 FTE positions. Funding for the FY 2009 salary adjustment is appropriated in HF 2700.

Section 1

Appropriates moneys from the Road Use Tax Fund to the DOT for FY 2009. Includes funding for producing driver's licenses; for salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes for various DOT areas; for payment to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for utility services and workers' compensation claims; for unemployment compensation; for payment to the General Fund for indirect cost recoveries; for reimbursement to the Auditor of State for audit expenses; for various costs associated with the county issuance of driver's licenses and vehicle registration and titles; for transfer to the Department of Public Safety for operation of a toll-free telephone road and weather conditions information system; for participation in the Mississippi River Parkway Commission; for membership in the North America's SuperCorridor Coalition; for development of an automated system to permit oversize and overweight vehicles; and for motor vehicle division field facility maintenance projects. Moneys appropriated in section 1 for costs associated with the production of driver's licenses, for the development of an automated permitting system for overdimension vehicles, and for motor vehicle division field maintenance projects do not revert but remain available as specified.
