

The following legislation of interest to the Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) was not included in the 2011 Iowa Acts for the DOT because it was item vetoed by Governor Branstad:

HF 648

A designated portion of Section 7 of HF 648 was item vetoed. The designated portion included the definition of "resident subcontractor" and language within the definition of "resident bidder."

SF 508

Section 36 of SF 508 was item vetoed. This section required departments to submit a plan to a legislative subcommittee detailing the expenditure of the federal funds designated for departmental administrative expenses.

SF 533

Section 6 of SF 533 was item vetoed. This section stated that for FY 2012 employees of the executive, judicial and legislative branches, shall not receive bonus pay unless otherwise authorized by law, required pursuant to a contract or to a collective bargaining agreement.

Section 45 of SF 533 was item vetoed. This section stated that for FY 2013 employees of the executive, judicial and legislative branches, shall not receive bonus pay unless otherwise authorized by law, required pursuant to a contract or to a collective bargaining agreement.

Section 90 of SF 533 was item vetoed. This section amended SF 236, Section 1, by changing the membership of the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy Council to 15 voting members. The additions of an employee of a county conservation board, who is a certified peace officer, and a Department of Natural Resources' conservation peace officer would have increased the membership.

Section 108 of SF 533 was item vetoed. This section required each department to separately track the budget and actual expenditures of each appropriation line item for contract services and employee training.
