

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE PIPE, 4 INCH

Linn County TAP-U-1187(799)--8I-57

Effective Date September 21, 2021

THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, SERIES 2015, ARE AMENDED BY THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATIONS AND ADDITIONS. THESE ARE SPECIAL PROVISIONS AND THEY SHALL PREVAIL OVER THOSE PUBLISHED IN THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.

157176.01 **DESCRIPTION.**

Install/extend sanitary sewer service pipe in situations where connecting to existing service within the tabulated length from new main is not possible due to deterioration of existing service pipe.

157176.02 MATERIALS.

Apply Article 4149.02 of the Standard Specifications.

157176.03 CONSTRUCTION.

- **A.** If connection of an existing sewer service to the proposed sewer main is not possible within 6 feet of the proposed main, notify the Engineer that sanitary sewer service pipe, 4 inch will need to be applied to pipe beyond 6 feet from the main.
- **B.** Construct sanitary sewer service from 6 feet outside of the main to the nearest location on the existing service where a connection can be made. Connection to existing service shall be made with a flexible rubber adapter with a stainless steel shear ring.

157176.04 METHOD OF MEASUREMENT.

Each Sanitary Sewer Service Pipe, 4 Inch will be measured in linear feet along the centerline of the replacement pipe.

157176.05 BASIS OF PAYMENT.

Payment will be made at the unit price per linear foot of Sanitary Sewer Service Pipe, 4 Inch. Unit price includes, but is not limited to, furnishing and installing replacement pipe and connections.
