 - 7 counties
 - 3 cities with population > 5,000





Application Process

Typical -

- Applications and instructions are available on the ECICOG website –
 October 1
- A pre-application must be submitted by October 30 simple, can be done via email
 - Include a brief project description, location, cost estimate
- Completed applications (two, type written copies) are due December 15

New in 2015 -

- Applications and instructions available September 1
- Pre-application workshop, mandatory for potential applicants October 14

Workshop Purpose

Federal transportation funding programs are fairly complex, and can add considerably to the time and cost of projects. The workshop will ensure that potential applicants have a good understanding of the programs and process before submitting an application.

- STP funds are suballocated to each county
- All applications received from within each county will be forwarded to the respective boards of supervisors for review and prioritization
- TTAC will review the priorities
- Policy Committee will consider TTAC recommendation
