State Legislative Activity



State Legislative Activity

- Iowa DOT Omnibus Bill
 - Passed on June 5 awaiting Governor signature
 - "Non-controversial"
 - Update Iowa Code chapters 307 and 307A
 - Remove or update a few outdated aviation and rail sections
 - Update some driver license issues
 - IRP late fees and undercover license plates
 - Commercial Learner's Permit



State Legislative Activity

- Revenue Package
 - 10 cents per gallon plus few fees
 - Estimated total revenue of \$213 million per year
 - 47.5% to DOT; 32.5% to Counties; 20% to Cities
 - Passed on February 24
 - Signed on February 25
 - Effective on March 1
 - $-\ \$33$ million in projects were added to the Department's FY 2015 program on March 10



State Legislative Activity

- 2016 2020 Improvement Program
 - Adopted June 9
 - An additional \$501 million in DOT highway improvements were programmed
 - Projects included in program as a result of the additional revenue are identified in the back of program
 - "Under a microscope"

Federal Legislative Activity

The Process is:

- Interesting to some ...
 - Frustrating to others ...
 - · A Mystery to many ...
 - Ignored by most ... and
 - Dominated by funding issues



Federal Legislative Activity

- Surface Transportation Program Authorization
 - 2nd Extension of MAP-21 expires July 31, 2015
 - Without extension cannot access HTF
 - Need to ensure that adequate funding is in the trust fund
 - Need \$3 billion to get to end of FY 2015
 - Estimated to need \$8 billion to get to the end of calendar 2015
 - Estimated from \$85 \$90 billion for 6-year bill



Federal Legislative Activity

- · Need Stable Federal Funding
 - More than a decade of investing more than available receipts into the trust fund
 - Estimates vary but \$16 billion+/- per year is necessary for current investment levels
 - Support for transportation investments but not enough support to find revenues to pay for it



Federal Legislative Activity

- Federal Funding Options have been identified (for many years) but no action taken
 - Increase in current fuel taxes
 - · With or without indexing fuel rates
 - Mileage based user fee
 - Revenues from Corporate tax reform
 - Including options dealing with overseas profits
 - 5% tax on certain imports
 - Tax on crude oil exports



Federal Legislative Activity

- Many hearings have been held by all of the relevant Congressional Committees to discuss future federal transportation programs
 - Policy Committees
 - House Transportation and Infrastructure
 - Senate Environment and Public Works
 - Senate Banking
 - Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation
 - Revenue Committees
 - House Ways and Means
 - Senate Finance



Federal Legislative Activity

- Congressional hearings are scheduled:
 - House Ways and Means (June 17)
 - Senate Finance (June 18)
 - Senate EPW markup of highway bill (June 24)
- Ways and Means hearing is "to explore new ideas to close the shortfall once and for all."



Federal Legislative Activity

- There is no evidence that Congress is willing to face this issue.
- It has been 15 years since there has been enough revenue to meet outlays
- 7 years of backfilling the HTF with general fund revenues
- Some talk about finding additional revenues for the federal-aid highway program
- Some are looking to reduce the federal role in transportation programs



Federal Legislative Activity

- GROW AMERICA
 - Administration's Reauthorization Proposal
 - 6-year bill; \$478 billion
 - New and expanded programs
 - Increase funding from Corporate Tax Reform



Federal Legislative Activity

- Transportation Empowerment Act (TEA)
 - Reduce gasoline from 18.4 cents to 3.7 cents
 - Reduce diesel from 24.4 cents to 5.0 cents
- · Eliminate the Mass Transit Account
- Focus on interstate highways
- Limiting the federal role transfer most responsibility to the States
- Eliminate restrictive and costly red tape



Federal Legislative Activity

- However, Transportation is still very popular with members of Congress
 - Congressman Shuster, Senator Inhofe, Senator Boxer,
 Congressman DeFazio, Congressman Mica
- Congressman Ryan
 - Year end business tax overhaul combined with a multiyear highway bill
- Senator Hatch
 - Timetable for business tax package into next year and possibly 2017



Federal Legislative Activity

- FY 2016 Appropriations Status
 - House passed bill June 9
 - $-\operatorname{Best}$ hope is for level funding
 - Can't pass increase in user fees
 - Will be difficult to get some GF transfers
 - Expect to continue funding with a series of Continuing Resolutions
