
- Chapter 4: Transit
  - Between 2,963–5,761 persons in the MPO area have no household vehicles available.
  - Between 2,240–4,238 persons have a medical condition that results in them giving up driving.
  - Between 14.7–22.6 percent of households have used a bus for travel at least a few times a year.




Figure 4.8: Responses to Which Two of the Following Options Would Best Improve MET Transit Service




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#### **Physical Activity Access Project**

- Led by the Iowa Dept of Public Health
- Four MPO/RPAs involved
- Focus on low-income seniors
- Funding through SNAP-Ed
  - Nutrition
  - Physical Activity





- Surveyed 97 residents of lowincome senior housing
  - Demographic questions
     (age group, race, English language)
  - Mode share, distance comfortable walking
  - Up to 3 destinations travel to most (a mini travel survey)
