--JARC projects must derive from a joint public transit / human services transportation planning process, such as lowa's Passenger Transportation Development Plan

- Solicited new JARC proposals to expend funds.
- Received 6 urban area proposals, 5 rural/small urban proposals, and statewide DOT proposal
