

# Public Transit Infrastructure Grant program

- Program created by 2006 General Assembly
  - Funds vertical infrastructure projects for public transit
  - All 35 transit systems are eligible
- 2015 General Assembly
  - Appropriated \$1.5 million for FY 2016
- \$143,807 available for reprogramming
- Total FY 16 Available Funding: \$1,643,807

# Public Transit Infrastructure Grant program

- Project selection criteria
  - No more than 40% of the appropriation can be awarded to an individual transit system.
  - Structural integrity of existing facilities
  - Safety enhancements to existing facilities
  - New facilities
  - Projects should be capable of completion in 18 months

# FY 2016 Public Transit Infrastructure Grant program

- Six applications received
- \$1,643,807 available
- Recommend funding five projects
