





Iowa's Public Transit System

- Public Transit Infrastructure Grant program





State Transit Assistance Program

State Transit Assistance (STA) formula\$14,124,000Rides/expense, miles/expense, local support

STA Special projects set-aside

<u>\$300,000</u>

Total FY 2017 STA projection

\$14,424,000

Public Transit Infrastructure Grants program (PTIG)

- Program created by 2006 General Assembly
 - Funds vertical infrastructure projects for public transit
 - All 35 public transit systems are eligible
- 2016 General Assembly
 Appropriated \$1.5 million for FY 2017
- \$53,116 available for reprogramming
- Total FY 17 Available Funding: \$1,553,116

Public Transit Infrastructure Grants program

- Project selection criteria
 - No more than 40% of the appropriation can be awarded to an individual transit system.
 - Structural integrity of existing facilities
 - Safety enhancements to existing facilities
 - New facilities
 - Projects should be "shovel ready" and capable of completion in 18 months

Public Transit Infrastructure Grants program

- Nine applications received
- \$1,553,116 available
- Recommend funding five projects
