

Transit Director

Region XII COG seeks qualified applicants wishing to apply their experience and business acumen to serve the public in the role of Western Iowa Transit Director. This position manages all aspects of the COG's public transit enterprise, which gets people to work, school, medical appointments, and other destinations. The position answers to the Executive Director and serves on the agency's management team. The Transit Director is responsible for meeting revenue and service delivery goals while managing the budget, personnel, service provision, and contract compliance. Relationship-building is important in this public-sector position, as is flexibility and creativity. This is a rare opening due to retirement of a long-term employee in an agency that enjoys a high degree of local support and statewide respect. Training will be offered during the introductory period. A bachelor's degree in business, transportation logistics, management, or a related field is required. Extensive related experience may be considered in lieu of a degree. The preferred candidate will have fleet management and personnel experience. Familiarity with federal and/or state program management and reporting is ideal but not required. Candidates should have excellent interpersonal skills, and unquestionable ethics. The successful candidate will have or will be expected to acquire a CDL and will be subject to a background check. The starting range for the position is anticipated to be \$65,000 - \$75,000 (depending on qualifications). The position is covered under IPERS and comes with leave, health insurance, and other benefits.
