University Blvd., Ames, Iowa on Monday, June 17, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. CDT for the purpose of considering operating and capital financial assistance from the Federal Transit Administration and the Iowa Department of Transportation for the following programs: State Transit Assistance (STA), 5339 (Bus and Bus Facilities Formula Grants), Public State Infrastructure Grant (PTIG), and 5310 (Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals With Disabilities Program).

CyRide will request Public Transit Infrastructure Grant (PTIG) funding in the amount of \$600,000 to be matched with 20% local funding (\$150,000) for Fire Mitigation Building Improvements.
