Said application will also include projects to be applied for in FY2022 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307, Section 5310, and/or Section 5339 programs of the U.S. DOT. The FTA Section 5307 program provides federal funds to be used for the operating and capital needs of Coralville Transit. Section 5310 provides funding for programs focusing on persons with disabilities and Section 5339 is a discretionary capital funding program.
