NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TO ALL TAXPAYERS OF THE IOWA CITY URBANIZED AREA AND TO OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Public notice is hereby given that the University of Iowa will conduct a public hearing on the University's FY2023 Iowa Department of Transportation Consolidated Transit Funding grant application. The application will be for approximately \$829,176 (4.96%) in State Transit Assistance formula funds to be used for operating and/or purchasing capital items for University of Iowa CAMBUS during FY2023. Said application will also include a listing of projects to be applied for in FY2023 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307, Section 5310, and/or Section 5339 programs. The FTA Section 5307 program provides federal funds to be used for the operating and capital needs of University of Iowa CAMBUS. Section 5310 provides funds for programs targeting persons with special needs, and Section 5339 is a discretionary capital funding program. Section 5307, Section 5310, and/or Section 5339 projects to be applied for in FY2023 include (total cost and federal amount):

The proposals in this notice, including the Program of Projects, will become final unless amended and republished.
